Offices Located in the Distillery Building Without Power Tuesday, October 6th

Westminster, Tuesday, October 6, 2015 – Due to a transformer malfunction, the Distillery Building located at 10 Distillery Drive, Westminster is without power today, Tuesday, October 6, 2015.

Original estimates indicated that the repairs would be completed by 7:30 am, but unfortunately crews will be working throughout most of the workday today to repair the problem.

The Distillery Building houses Carroll County Bureau of Housing, the Local Management Board and the Transportation Administration. None of these offices will be open at the Distillery Building today. County staff associated with these offices will be operating from the Westminster Senior Center.

The building is also home to Human Services Programs (HSP), Access Carroll, Child Support Enforcement and Carroll Food Sunday. Staff for these organizations should contact their Supervisor for information on reporting to work.

The public is asked to please call 410-386-3800 with any questions.

Electric service is expected to be restored later today. Normal building operations are expected to resume tomorrow.
