County begins recycling program for used frying oil, kitchen grease

April 27, 2009 - Carroll County's Recycling office is beginning a collection program for used frying oil and kitchen grease. Waste kitchen oil and grease will be accepted in designated containers, free of charge, from Carroll County residents at the Recycling Center drop-off area at the Northern Landfill, 1400 Baltimore Blvd., Westminster. Businesses may call the landfill at 410-386-4550 to see if they are eligible to participate and coordinate their drop-off.

All of the used frying oil and kitchen grease is recycled into high energy fat used in animal feeds or into biofuel replacement for traditional fossil fuels.

Hours of operation for the Northern Landfill are Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Saturday, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m. For additional information, call Recycling Manager Maria Myers at 410-386-2035 or the Northern Landfill at 410-386-4550.
