# First snowy Saturday will mark Sledfest

**January 28, 2010** – If a building winter storm heads north, Carroll County could see its first snowy weekend of the new year. Weather permitting, sledders can celebrate by heading to Piney Run Park this Saturday, Jan. 30, for Sledfest. The event will take place if there are at least 4 inches of snow on the park grounds by 7 a.m. Park gates will open at 10 a.m. and close at 4 p.m. Sledding will be allowed in the overflow parking area behind the maintenance building.

There will be a \$2 per vehicle program fee payable at the gatehouse upon entry in the park (cash or check only). You may call the gatehouse at 410-795-3274 starting at 9:30 the morning of 2010's first snowy Saturday to confirm the event. The Board of County Commissioners sponsors these and other activities at Piney Run Park and Nature Center through the Department of Recreation And Parks.
