Qualifications & Requirements

- Must be a United States citizen, able to read, write and speak English language and will reach the minimum age of 21 before the end of the Police Academy.
- Possession of a General Education Development (GED) certificate or diploma recognized by the State Board of Education
- Possession of a valid drivers license from state of residence; an applicant's license may not have been suspended, canceled or revoked in the three (3) years prior to application
- Must be eligible to possess and use a handgun.
- Successfully complete integrity questionnaire, physical fitness test, written examination, confidentiality questionnaire, oral interview board, polygraph, background investigation, physical/medical examination, psychological examination, and final command interview/ review.
