- Must be a United States citizen, able to read, write and speak English language and will reach the minimum age of 21 before the end of the Police Academy.
- Possession of a General Education Development (GED) certificate or diploma recognized by the State Board of Education
- Possession of a valid drivers license from state of residence; an applicant's license may not have been suspended, canceled or revoked in the three (3) years prior to application
- May not have been convicted of a felony or any crime involving moral turpitude
- Successfully pass a thorough background investigation, physical fitness test, written test, oral interview, psychological and polygraph examinations, medical review, and drug screen

Candidates that are currently a Certified law enforcement officer in the State of Maryland, or possess certification from a police academy that meets the standards recognized by the Maryland Police Training Commission may be eligible for accelerated processing and placement.
