“Sheriff’s Office Investigator to attend specialized training”

Westminster, Carroll County, Maryland, July 16, 2009 ---- To advance the investigative skills and continue the professional development of Carroll County’s law enforcement officers, Sheriff Ken Tregoning is pleased to announce the acceptance of Sergeant Brad Brown to the United States Secret Service Computer Evidence Recovery Training Course in Hoover, Alabama.

Sergeant Brown reports this Sunday, July 19th where he will attend classes for the next five (5) weeks with 24 Investigators from local law enforcement agencies across the nation. Participation is by invitation only, through a nomination process that included 71 potential applicants. During instruction, officers will participate in a wide range of practical and classroom instruction relating to the technical and legal aspects of computer forensics investigations.

Following his graduation, Sergeant Brown will return to his regular assignment as an investigator with the Carroll County Sheriff’s Office.
