“Sheriff’s Office Arrests Suspect for 1st Degree Assault”

Westminster, Carroll County, Maryland, July 4th, 2011---- Deputies from the Carroll County Sheriff's Office arrested Allen Stanley Bolster, 43, of Green Street in Westminster, on a warrant for 1st degree assault in the stabbing of a 56 year old man in the woods to the rear of the Carroll County Farm Museum, which occurred on Sunday, July 3rd.

At approximately 8pm on July 3rd, an altercation occurred between the victim and Bolster. During this time, the victim was both cut with a knife and punched. He was transported to Carroll Hospital Center for further care.

During the subsequent investigation, deputies learned of the suspect's identity, applied for and received a warrant for Bolster's arrest for:

- 1st degree assault
- 2nd degree assault
- Reckless endangerment

At approximately 4pm on Monday, July 4th, Bolster was located back in the area of the Carroll County Farm Museum and taken into custody by Sheriff's deputies.
