

NOTICE OF REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS FOR OUTDOOR ADVERTISING SIGNS

The County Commissioners of Carroll County, Maryland, adopted Ordinance No. 03-19, which repealed Section 223-139 (Use-off-the-premises signs) of the Code of Public Local Laws and Ordinances of Carroll County, and replaced it in its entirety with new regulations for use-off-the-premises, also known as outdoor advertising signs. The purpose of this notice is to alert the public and interested persons and entities that under Ordinance No. 03-19, §223-139C, all nonconforming signs shall be registered with the Zoning Administrator by December 16, 2003, by completing a registration application, including, but not limited to: the location of the sign including distances from all property boundaries and roadways; the height, size and dimensions of the sign; the building materials that the sign is constructed of; an affidavit of the property owner; and an affidavit of the lessee of the property and/or developer of the sign. Non-conforming signs are those billboards and other outdoor advertising signs that existed prior to August 18, 2003.
